KENYA KIDS EASTER BASKETS


Easter is March 31, 2024, and the money for the baskets has to be sent in by the end of March. So the Easter Bunny will be appearing a few Sundays in March.

Lent Season 2024 Fasting, Prayer, and Scripture Matthew 4:4

Today we are reading from Matthew 4:4 where Christ was exercising his faith to prepare himself for the next battle. I chose the word exercise carefully, because just as we do for our physical health, we need to exercise our spirit in order for it to remain strong.

Christ had been fasting in the desert for 40 days when he encountered the devil who encouraged him to turn stones into bread to relieve his hunger. Christ replied,

Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God.

Now, imagine a dialogue between two speakers. Christ represents the light, the devil represents the darkness, we are the audience, and the topic of the panel discussion topic is human needs. One side assures that if you have your basic needs met, you will be satisfied, while the other tests you by reminding you of the times you thought that if you did this or got that, you would be happy and satisfied despite an endless list of needs.

When Christ said, "live not by bread alone," he was not denying that many of our material needs are good or needed. Instead his message reminds us that we also belong to the spiritual world with its different meanings of sustenance and satisfaction. So do not ignore your material needs, but do not be deceived into believing that you will truly live if your material needs are the main or only focus in your life.

Christ has the power to perform miracles, yet he refused to turns stones to bread when he was hungry, because he reserves such miracles for the powerless and forgotten. Christ teaches us that we may be hungry for bread, but we must trust in the Lord to provide spiritual sustenance.

The way to maintain a strong Christian spirit is to keep exercising. First find a special place where you can feel God's presence and where you can talk and listen without interruption. Second, fast to reconnect your lifestyle with your spiritual values. Finally, listen to the word of the Lord who reminds us to define ourselves according to God's will.


